## Announcements

### Preparation for Pascha

Pascha (Easter) is the Feast of Feasts. We will spend the next 40+ days (40 days plus Holy Week) making sure we appreciate and receive the fullness of the gift of Christ's death and resurrection. We call this the "Great Fast".rem We prepare using the biblical and ascetical acts of **prayer, fasting and almsgiving**. Please consider these three separately and intensify them in anticipation of Pascha.

-Flocknote prayer resources and parish liturgical prayer will reflect the season.

-Please consider our Byzantine traditions when it comes to fasting: (From the Typicon)

"In the Great Fast, abstinence from meat, fish, dairy products, alcohol and foods cooked in oil was prescribed for all days, except days of mitigation. All Saturdays and Sundays, Wednesday and Friday of the Fifth Week (April 3rd and 5th) and the Leave-taking of Annunciation (March 26th) were mitigations for wine and oil. The Feast of the Annunciation (March 25th) and Palm and Flowery Sunday (April 14th) were general mitigations. **The Ruthenian Metropolia prescribes strict abstinence (from meat and dairy products) on the First Monday of the Great Fast (March 4th) and Great and Holy ("Good") Friday (April 19th) (for parishioners 18+) and abstinence from meat on all Wednesdays and Fridays (all parishioners).**"

-More intentionally sacrifice time and resources for your neighbor.

-More ideas will be shared in parish emails.

#### **Info. From the Archdiocese of Denver**

This week a bill that would abolish the death penalty in the state of Colorado will be introduced in the Senate.

We believe that all people have a natural right to life, because every human being is made in the image and likeness of God, who alone is Lord of life from its beginning until its end (cf. Genesis 1: 26-28).

The state of Colorado has other means available besides the death penalty to exact justice and render a criminal unable to do harm. We need to continue the reform of our criminal justice system, and we need to impose punishment in a way that protects society from violence while avoiding further killing under official guise.
